The Heartsaver Hero award is our way of saying thank you for performing the heroic act of CPR, a critical link in our chain of survival. We want to recognize the heroes that have stepped in to help save a life during an emergency.

Crews responded to reports of CPR in progress. Within minutes of arriving on scene, crews took over CPR, placed AED pads and defibrillated the patient. They continued to treat the patient with life-saving medication and continued defibrillation. After seven minutes on scene, providers achieved return of spontaneous circulation and was showing signs of purposeful movement. Excellent care continued to the hospital where care was transferred to the awaiting hospital team. The patient was eventually discharged from the hospital with no deficits. A job well done by the Great Lakes Fire crews.
